# Create A Slideshow


**Apple iPad**

## STEP 1

Open the "Photos" app.




## STEP 2



Create a new album by hitting the + button. Name this album something interesting like "Make extra cash" because the album name is displayed on the first slide.

## STEP 3

Move images you want for your slideshow into this new Album.




In the new album click "Select" in the top right and then "Add" in the top left. That lets you add from your collection of photos.



## STEP 4

Now that you've got your special Album set-up with all the images that you need, you're ready to make the slideshow. All you need to do is hit the "Slideshow" button in the top right.



The slideshow will automatically start playing. Touch the screen to bring up Options (bottom right) and tap that adjust the speed and transitions.



Choose a theme (Dissolve is recommended), turn the music to 'None' and turn Repeat on. Set the speed slider all the way down to "turtle".

As you can see the album name "Test" is displayed over the top of my first slide (a photo of my son's blankie toy).

# Create A Slideshow

## Android Tablet

There are many different slideshow apps for Android on the Google Play Store. I've chosen PhotoStory (also known as Free Slideshow Maker) because it's super easy to use and very cheap to buy if the ads annoy you.

### STEP 1

Go to the Play Store and download "Free Slideshow Maker & Video Editor" (also known as "PhotoStory") by FunMedia Studio



### STEP 2

Open the app and Choose the red icon for "Editor". Choose which folder your images are in and then select your images. When you select an image, it'll appear below the blue "next" button.



### STEP 3


Once you've selected all your images hit the "Next" button. Your slideshow automatically starts playing.

At the bottom you'll see a number of tools. Find the second from the right, "Duration".



## STEP 4

Set the duration to 10s with the slider and make sure you set it to all photos. Then click OK.



## STEP 5

Back in the editor screen, you can scroll through the tools and find "Transition".




## STEP 6

Choose a simple transition, such as "Fade" and click the tick at the top right. The app will ask you if you want to apply the transition to all your slides. You do :)

## STEP 7



Now you're ready to export your slideshow. Hit the "share" button on the top right in the Editor.

You're now asked what quality you want to export at, choose the best quality (Full HD).

It'll export your slideshow as a video that you can play it anytime you want.
